One Health for One World

Improving lives knows no boundaries. Abt takes a holistic approach, examining multiple perspectives from animal and human population health to ecosystems and economies. By incorporating related sciences, we help clients transcend cultural lines, physical borders, and unique disciplines to solve their toughest challenges.

Program examples:

Making Environmental Data Meaningful

We have tracked more than three million pounds of toxic chemicals released by waste management agencies across the U.S. By creating an innovative online tool, communities and other stakeholders can discover what chemicals have been released into the air, water and ground by state, county or zip code.

Studying Human Health, Climate and Infectious Disease

Abt has mapped changes in climate to human health and infectious diseases like Dengue fever, West Nile and Zika viruses. Our lab and field studies of mosquitoes are helping to identify new and emerging diseases and answer whether the diseases can be transmitted to humans. Combined with our climate research, Abt gives clients novel insights and geographic evidence on how to prepare and respond to the latest hot zones.

Designing a Research Infrastructure to Prevent Pandemics

Epidemiological studies can keep an influenza outbreak from spreading. Since the 2009 H1N1 pandemic, Abt has been supporting the CDC's flu research agenda for rapid response. We developed and continue to maintain a research platform that tracks flu in multiple countries and populations. This monitoring provides critical data to help avert a pandemic, and evaluates antiviral and vaccine effectiveness against new flu strains.

Data-Driven Science

Abt has more than 50 years of experience in rigorous research, monitoring and evaluation, and offers a worldwide network of partners and collaborators.

Program examples:

Quantifying the Impacts of Disasters on Health & Economies

We illuminate the impacts to marine life, public health and local, state and regional economies after environmental and manmade disasters, such as *Deepwater Horizon*. These assessments have informed restoration efforts along the Gulf of Mexico, as well as other regions of the U.S.

Addressing the Nation's Mental and Substance Use Problems

Abt supported the development of the *Surgeon General's Report on Alcohol, Drugs, and Health*, which reviews the best available science on the health consequences of substance misuse and substance use disorders, including prescription drugs and opioids. We also investigate the effects of mental illness and trauma on military personnel, their families, and other populations.

Designing Innovative Models for Better Payment Decisions

Abt helps clients understand health policy changes and provides better ways to measure key indicators, like provider performance and quality of care across total patient experience. Our economic modeling for the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services is providing sound evidence to test new reforms before implementation, ensuring the greatest benefit to patients and providers.
